
Carbon Literacy is relevant climate change learning that catalyses action to reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The Carbon Literacy Project works to provide access to this learning to everyone who lives, works and studies and is expanding rapidly across the UK and beyond.

The Carbon Literacy Project is based on the key aim that if we are to cut our carbon emissions by the kind of reductions demanded of us by science, then we will need to change culture alongside technology. Carbon Literacy training is offered through workplaces, educational institutions and communities.

Carbon Literate citizens understand how climate change will affect them – both geographically and sectorally – and have acquired the knowledge and skills to lower their carbon footprint, with typical realised carbon savings of 5-15% per person (Jacobs, 2018).

Elevate has been quality assessed by the Carbon Literacy Project to deliver accredited training and is the world's first Carbon Literate business development organisation. Graduates are certified as Carbon Literate following completion of the course. These individuals demonstrate knowledge of the steps needed to become carbon neutral and commit to a personal and professional pledge. There is high profile branding for organisations putting their people through a Carbon Literacy programme.



## How do you become a Carbon Literate Organisation?

The journey to become a CLO is illustrated on the diagram.

To have the best chance of becoming the world's first carbon literate organisation in your sector, we would recommend applying for Bronze as soon as the first cohort is certified, and then upgrade to Silver once further criteria has been satisfied.

- Design and development of bespoke course
- Delivery of initial cohort (including at least one board member)
- Delegate certification fees
- Application for CLO status
- Course and CLO accreditation fees charged separately


